### Quarry Happenings...

At the February 8 meeting of the Quarry Commission, Commission members reviewed and discussed Hanson Quarry blasting analysis data from December 2015 and January 2016. There were 13 blasts recorded in December and 12 blasts in January. In December, the highest ground vibration measured was .270 in/sec on December 4 and the highest air blast measured was 114.8 dB on December 3. The highest ground vibration measured in January was .210 in/sec on January 8 and the highest air blast measured was 113.3 dB on January 25. These blast data captured by the monitoring system show all blasts were within the guidelines outlined in City Ordinance 34.

Citizen Blast Reports were filed by 4 residents for the Jan 8 blast. Blast Reports were also filed by one resident for blasts on 4, 7, and 15 December. Commission members reviewed the monitor data for all those dates and discussed with Hanson representatives reasons the effects may have seemed more pronounced for those residents. No residents appeared before the commission to provide additional comments. Members also discussed placement of the roving blast monitor for the next two months. Commissioners agreed to participate in a training session at the next Quarry Commission meeting on April 11, when VibraTech will bring a blast monitor and demonstrate how it works. Residents who wish to make a comment about a blast or have an input for the Commission are invited to attend the April 11 meeting at 7:00 PM and to stay to learn more about this monitoring process.
