The City's authorized trash collector, Republic Services, has discontinued accepting tube type monitors and televisions effective January 31, 2019. This includes curbside and dumpster disposal. Please be advised that it is increasingly hard to find anyone to accept these items without incurring a significant fee.

NEW LOCATION FOR DUMPSTERS AND THE COMAL RECYCLING TRUCK

DUMPSTER MATERIALS

Accepted Materials:

Shrubs, tree branches, woody vines, other herbaceous and woody plants
 BBQ grills (without compressed gas tanks), carpeting, fencing, furniture, toilets
 Mattresses, water heaters, appliances

Materials Not Accepted:

Household trash, construction debris, hazardous materials (paints, cleaners)
 Compressed gas tanks, tires, televisions (older styles with picture tubes)
 Computers, medical waste,
 Appliances that contain freon. Appliances certified freon free will be accepted.
