

Proclamation

WHEREAS, the City of Garden Ridge has determined that certain restrictive measures are required to delay potentially serious water shortage problems from impacting the health, safety, and welfare of the Garden Ridge community; and

WHEREAS, the City of Garden Ridge has adopted Ordinance No. 61 which establishes the Drought Management Plan for the City of Garden Ridge; and

WHEREAS, Section 3 – Demand Reduction Measures of Ordinance No. 61 sets the trigger points of the various stages of the Drought Management Plan in accordance with the Edwards Aquifer Authority’s J-17 Well Level; and

WHEREAS, Section 4 – Emergency Water Use Reduction, 4.01 – Declaration of Emergency Stages authorizes the Mayor of the City of Garden Ridge to order by means of a Proclamation the implementation of Stages 1 through 5 of the City of Garden Ridge Drought Management Plan through trigger conditions established in Ordinance No. 61.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that I, Robb Erickson, Mayor of Garden Ridge, Texas, do hereby order the City of Garden Ridge in Stage 1 of the Drought Management Plan effective July 5, 2022, due to the level of the Edwards Aquifer Authority Test Well J-17 having reached a trigger level of 640’ and such stage shall remain in effect until there is an announcement by the City of Garden Ridge that Stage 1 has been cancelled or that Stage 2 is in effect.
